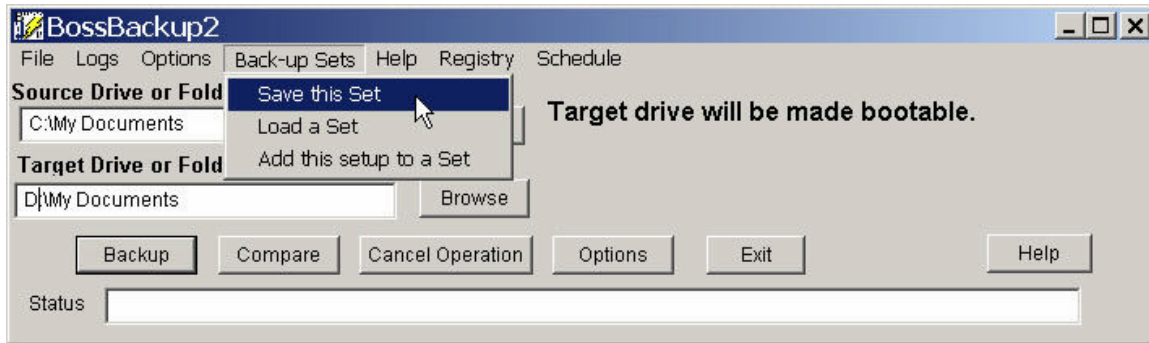


Automating Boss Backup 2

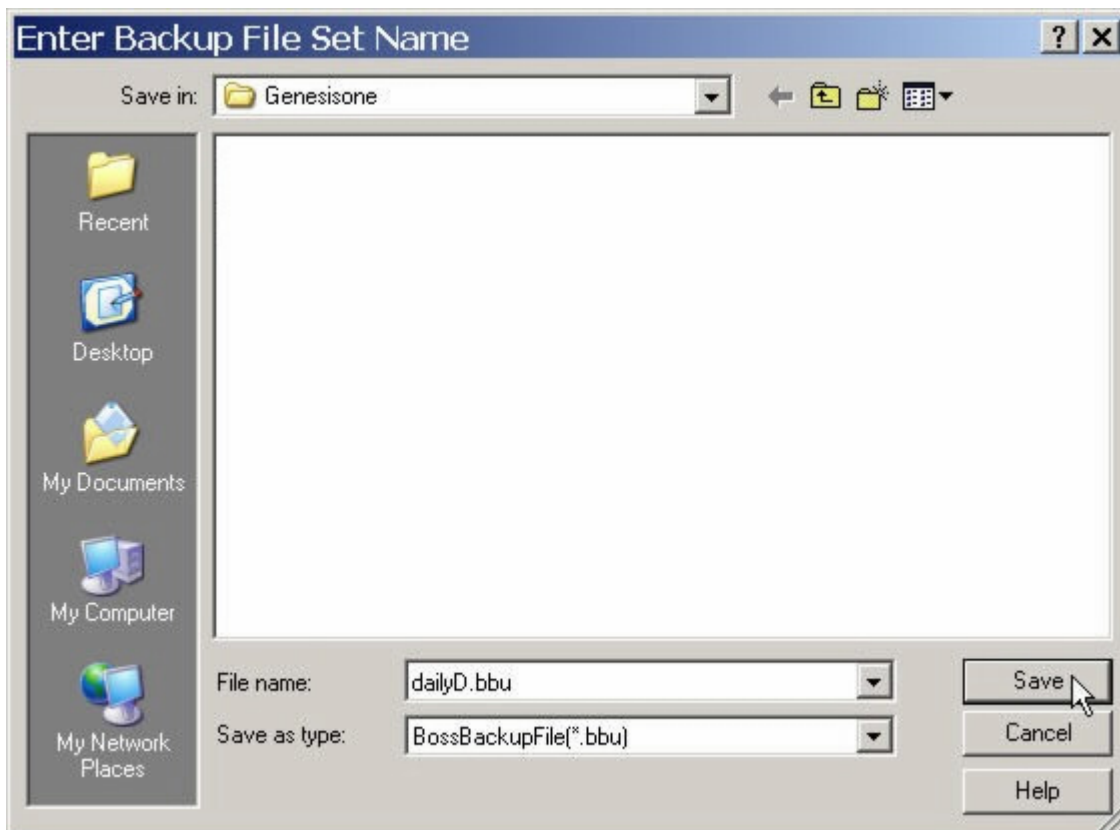
Create a “Backup Set”

A backup set is a file that you create and when executed will back up drive to drive, or folder to folder. This set when created may contain any number of drive to drive or folder to folder operations.

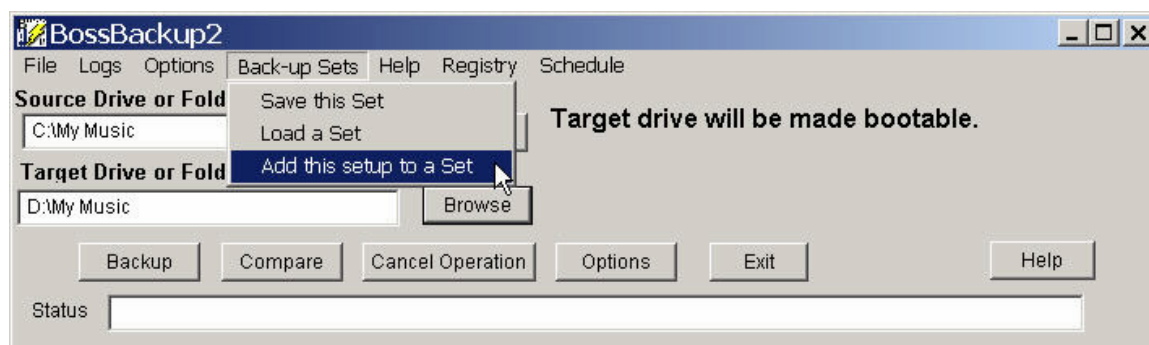
Open BossBackup2 and select your “Source Drive or Folder” and your “Target Drive or Folder” then select “Back-up Sets/Save this Set”



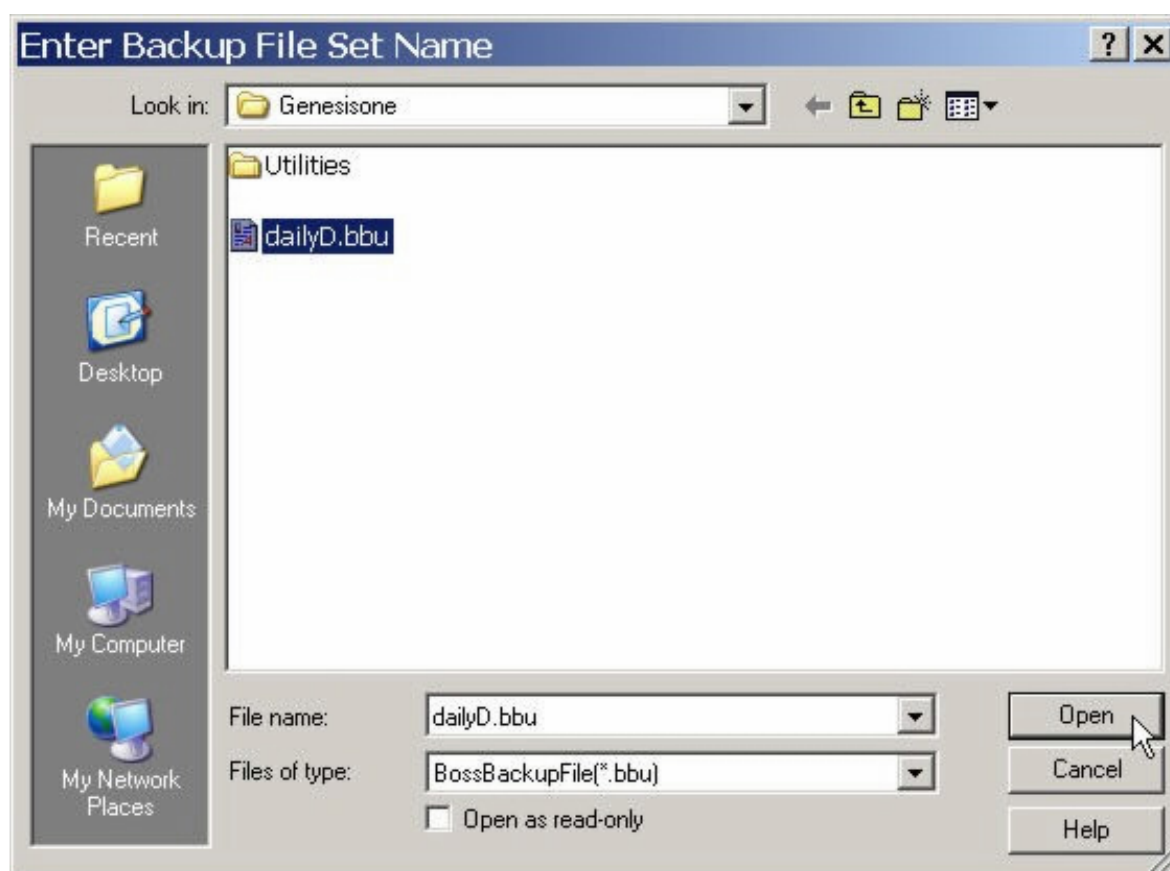
Name the set and click save.



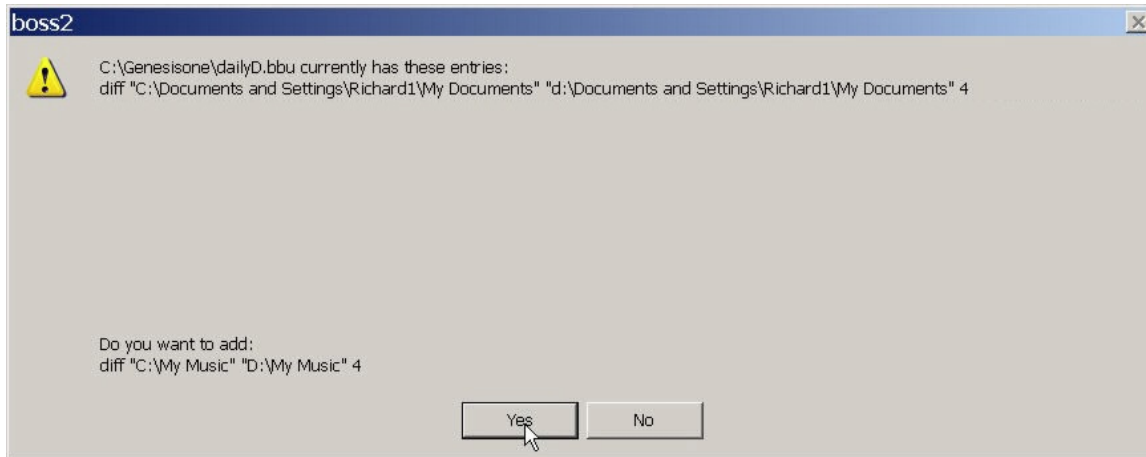
You may add another drive to drive or folder to folder operation to this set by selecting another “Source Drive or Folder” and “Target Drive or Folder” then select “Back-up Sets”/Add this Setup to a Set”



Select the .bbu file that this operation will be added to then click Open.



It will ask for confirmation, click Yes.



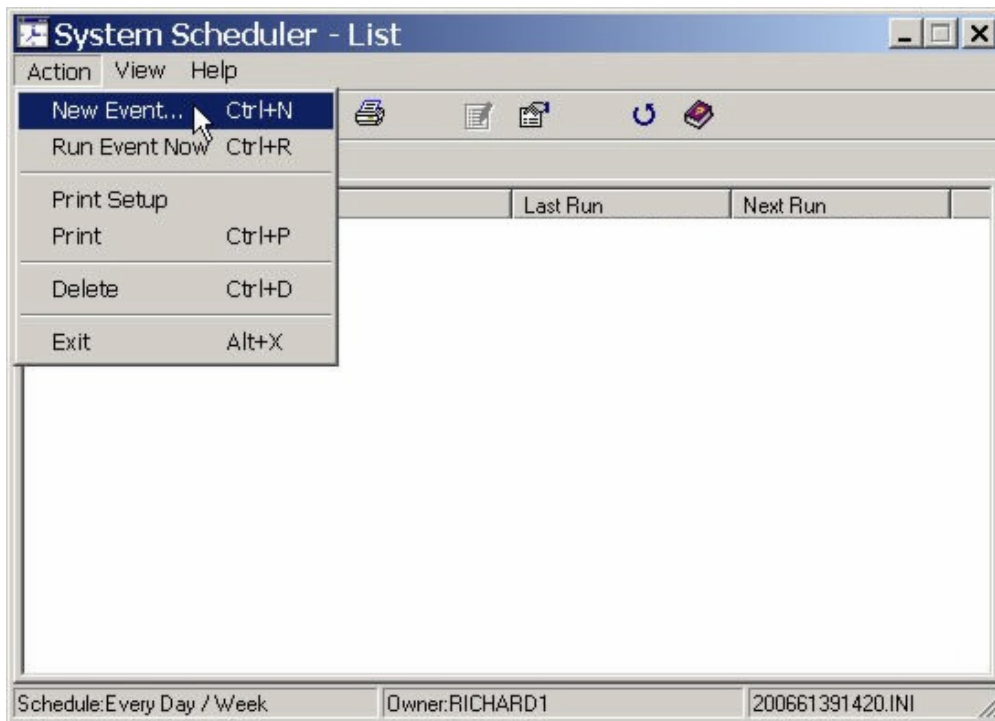
You may continue to add as many operations as you want.

When you are satisfied with your “Backup Set” download and install the Freeware (free) program called “System Scheduler” from the following URL address:

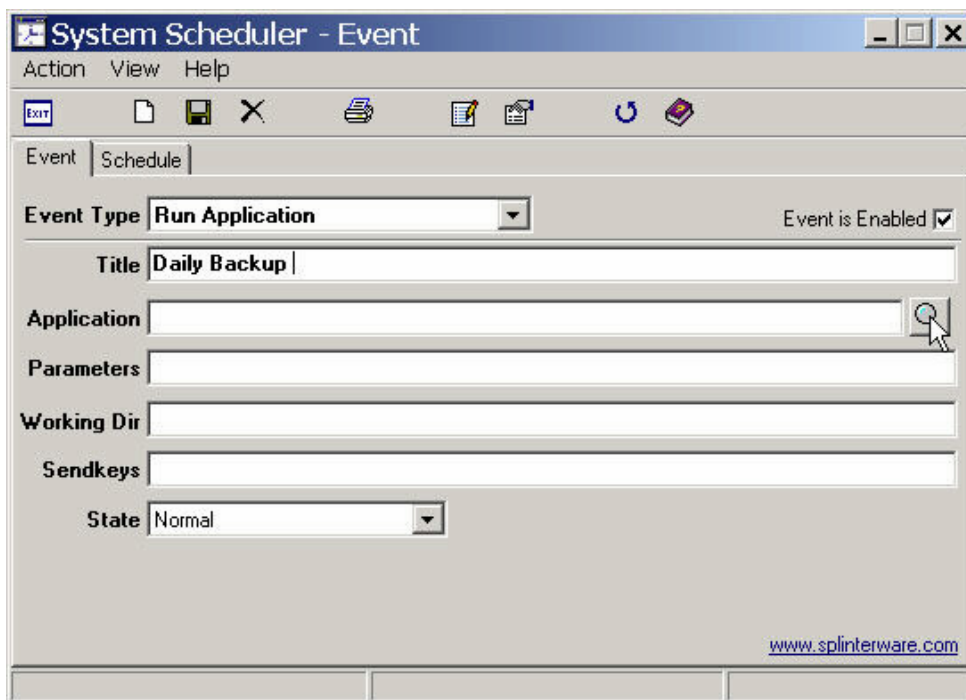

Automating the Event

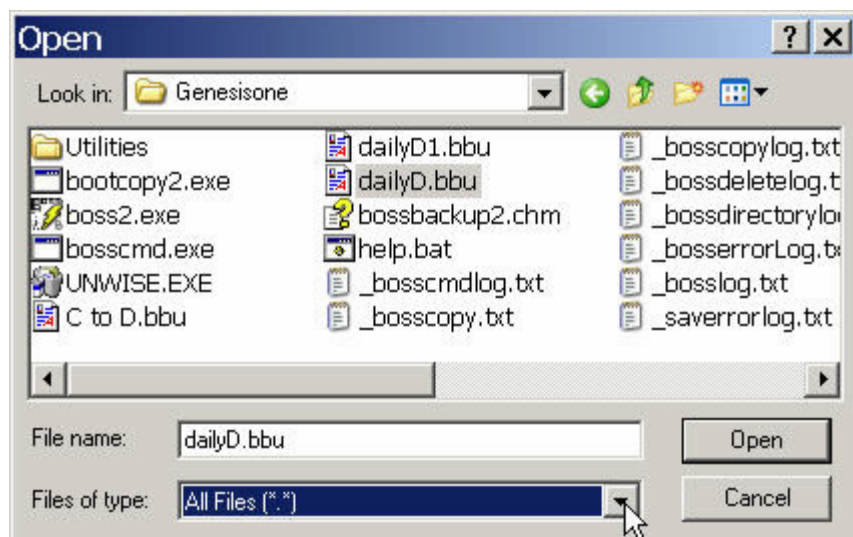
Open System Scheduler and select “Action/New Event...”



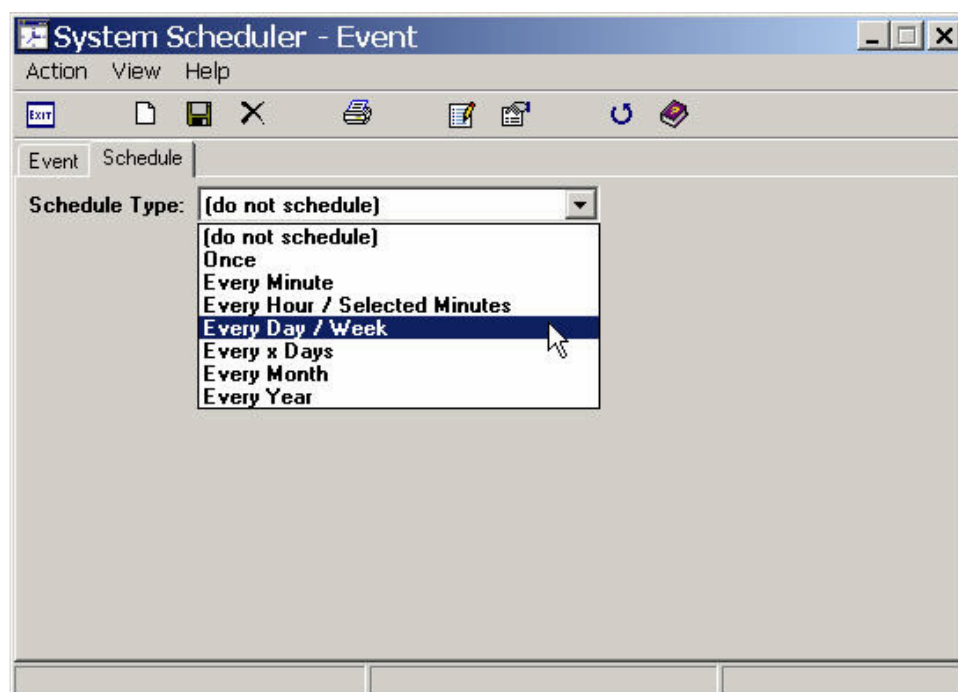
Give the Event a name in the “Title” text box, and in the “Application” text box use the directory select icon to select “dailyD.bbu” from the C:\Genesisone\ directory.



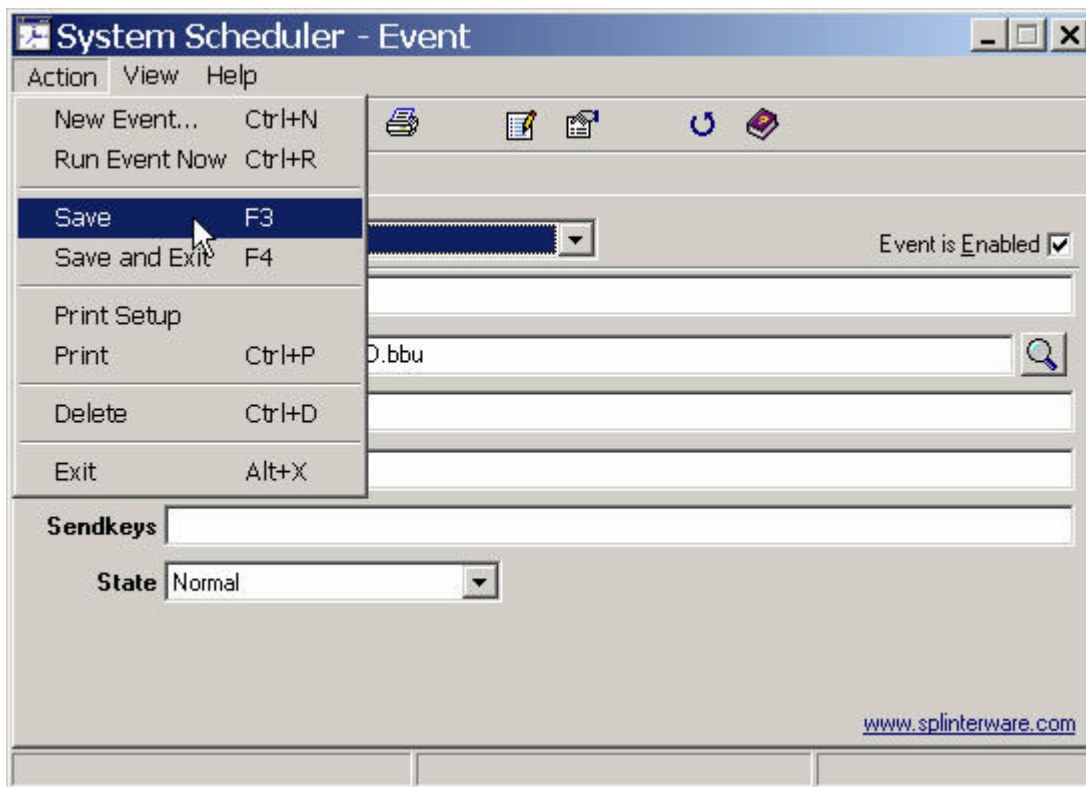
! Make sure you select “All Files (*.*)” by clicking on the drop down menu, to be able to see the .bbu file.



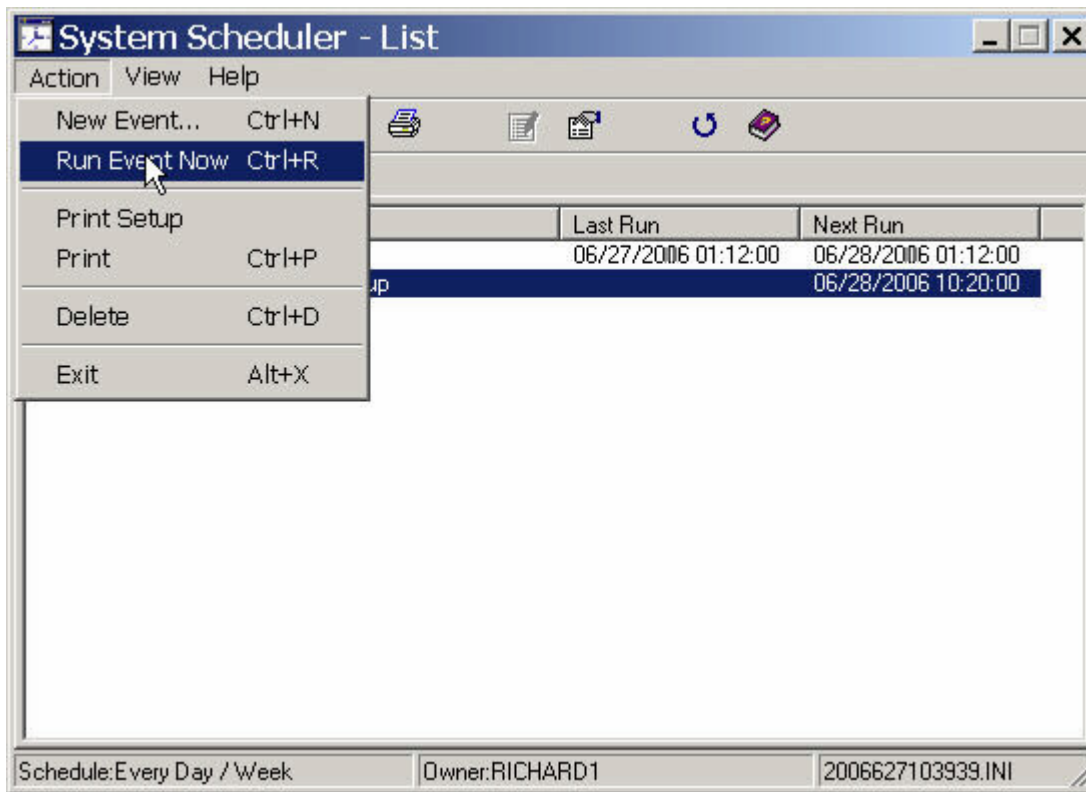
Click Open to save the operation. Then go to the “Scheduler” tab and choose a schedule.



Don't forget to save the event.



Once you have saved the event you can test it by selecting “Action/Run Event Now”



You can check to see if the operation has run by going to “View/System Logfile”
You may also use System Scheduler to automate any other event you want.
